The Saha lab has an open position for a Master's student; the lab uses a variety of biochemical, biophysical and cell biology techniques to study the role of macromolecular phase separation in germ cell fate.

The successful candidate will carry out research in the emerging field of phase separation in biological systems. He/she will address interesting hypotheses using microscopy approach on transgenic *C. elegans* strains generated using CRISPR/Cas9 and follow-up in vitro experiments. The ideal applicant should be highly motivated, enthusiastic to learn, and have a background in cell or molecular biology.

The successful candidate will receive a monthly stipend of € 500,- (a living allowance is also available for applicants from outside Vienna).
